HIGHWAYS ILLUMINATED.

HOLLYWOOD, May 7.--Incandescent street lights are being installed along the boulevard and side streets, and one circuit of about fifty lamps was first lighted Sunday evening. The preliminary expense of canvassing and installing experimental switches, and a large share of cost of this first circuit is borne by H. J. Whitley privately. Property holders are subscribing for the maintenance of lights in front of their holdings, and, as the cost is only about 40 or 50 cents per lot per month, it is expected that soon all of Hollywood will be illuminated.

Rev. Dr. J. H. Potts, one of the delegates to the Methodist General Conference, and editor of the Michigan Christian Advocate, will preach at the Hollywood Memorial Methodist Church Sunday morning. Rev. Stephen Duncan of Louisiana will preach at the same place in the evening. Rev. Dr. J. G. Evans of Chicago will preach at the Christian Church in the evening.
