A NEVENT took place at the Holly-wood Hotel Saturday evening. October 9, which throws light upon the trend of events in California. The Security Land and Loan Company, represented by its executive officers and a number of shareholders, invited a couple of hundred friends to cele-brate the return to the stockholders of the last cent of their original investment. The investment was heavy, the amount of land secured very large, and the enterprise had to be built up from the lowest founda-tions. The stockholders have received back all the money they put into the investment and there is property enough left around Corcoran to bring back at least 100 per cent. on the dol-lar net profits to the stockholders.

Perilous Times Encountered.

Half a score of the men who aided in carrying on the enterprise told by installments the story of the four years.
